



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ABOUT BORNO

Borno State is located at the North-Eastern corner of the country and occupies an area of 69,436sq km. This makes it one of the largest State in the Federation in terms of landmass. The State shares borders with three (3) countries of Niger Republic to the North, Chad Republic to the North and Cameroon to the East. The State has 27 Local Government Areas and a population of 2,596,589 as per the 1991 provisional census figure.

The Local Government Areas of the State are: Abadam, Askira Uba, Bama, Bayo, Biu, Chibok, Damboa, Dikwa, Gubio, Guzamala, Gwoza, Hawul, Jere, Kaga, Kala-Balge, Konduga, Kukawa, Kwaya Kusar, Mafa, Magumari, Maiduguri Metropolitan Council, Marte, Mobbar, Monguno, Ngala, Nganzai and Shani.

From the point of view of climate, Borno State is usually hot and dry for most part of the year and the rainy season lasts from June to September with an annual rainfall of between 500mm and 1,000 mm.

As to the people, the State is pluralistic in ethnic composition. The major ethnic groups include Kanuri, Babur/Bura, Marghi, Shuwa Arab, Waha, Mandara, Ghide, Wula, Fulani, Ngamargu, Chibok, Kanakuru and Koyam. Borno State is also divided into Emirates and are headed by Shehu and Emirs respectively while the Borno State Council of Emirs is headed by his Royal Highness, The Shehu of Borno.

Borno State which is located within the Lake Chad plains to the Biu Plateau is fertile for agricultural activities. Consequently, agriculture has been the main pre-occupation of its people as over 80% of the population is engaged in crop cultivation, animal husbandry, cattle rearing, fishing, trade and commerce. The State therefore has over 10,555,000 hectares of cultivable land suitable for the cultivation of crops such as millet, sorghum, rice wheat, groundnut, cotton maize, sweet potatoes, gum Arabic, fruits and vegetables. Livestock rearing is undertaken all over the State and constitute over 35% of the National Herd being the largest producer in the country and indeed the West African Sub Region. The State also possesses one of the richest fishing grounds in Nigeria. These include Lake Chad and sundry rivers of Yobe, Kumadugu, Yadzaram, Alau Dam, Hawul, Gongola and Ndivan. In view of this the State has been the major supplier of preserved fish to other parts of the country.

In addition, the State is endowed with mineral resources which when fully tapped, can sustain the economy of the State, these include potash, soda ash, trona, glass, ornamental limestone, quarts, gypsum, diatomite, feldspar, alum, kaolin and manganese which are available in commercial quantities.





RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

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The Financial Statements have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of the Finance (Control and Management) Act 1958 Cap 144 LFN as amended. The Financial Statements were prepared on the bases of Nigerian Format of Cash Basis International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS) and they comply with the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP).

As the Accountant General of the State, I am the Chief Accounting Officer of the receipts and payments of all funds. I take appropriate steps to fulfill my financial reporting responsibilities. I am responsible for establishing and maintaining adequate system of internal controls and that the system provides adequate and reasonable assurances that transactions are appropriately recorded and are within statutory authority. I ensure that proper accounting records are maintained and that judgments and estimates are reasonable and relevant to the content of the financial statements. I also ensure and take responsibility for the integrity and reliability of the Financial Statements. I confirm that the Financial Statements reflect the financial position and operations of Borno State Government as at 31st December, 2019. The Accountant General accepts responsibility for the integrity of this Financial Statements and their compliance with the Finance (Control and Management) Act 1958 as amended and the International Public Sector Accounting Standard (IPSAS) Cash Basis.

FINANCIAL ACCOUNTING AND REPORTING FRAMEWORK:

The financial reporting framework of the Borno State Government is anchored on the Cash Basis of International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS).

The standards integrated the Budget Performance Reporting on the Financial Statements. The accounting principles governing financial reporting are in accordance with the National Chart of Accounts and other detailed financial procedures in the Government Financial Regulations.

The Financial Statements have been prepared according to the Nigerian Format of the General Purpose Financial Statements (GPFS) governed by the International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS).

The Financial Statements presented are:

- i. Statement 1: Statement of Cash Flow
- ii. Statement 2: Statement of Assets and Liabilities
- iii. Statement 3: Statement of Consolidated Revenue Fund (CRF)
- iv. Statement 4: Statement of Capital Development Fund (CDF)

Accounting policies:

- 1. Accounting Terminologies/ Definitions:
 - i. Accounting Policies are the specific principles, bases convention, rules and practices adopted by the Borno state Government in preparing and presenting Financial Statements.
 - ii. **Cash** comprises cash in hand, demand deposits in financial institutions and cash equivalents.
 - iii. **Cash Equivalents** are short-term, highly liquid investments that are readily convertible to known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant

risk of changes in value.

- iv. Cash Basis means a basis of accounting that recognises transactions and other events only when cash is received or paid.
- v. **Cash flows** are inflows and outflows of cash. Cash flows exclude movements between items that constitute cash as these components are part of the cash management of the government rather than increases in the cash position controlled by government.
- vi. Cash Receipts are cash inflows
- vii. Cash Payments are cash outflows
- viii. **Cash Controlled by Borno State Government:** Cash is deemed to be controlled by Borno State Government when the government can freely use the available cash for the achievement of its objectives or enjoy benefit from the cash, and can also exclude or regulate the access of others to that benefit. Cash collected by, or appropriated or granted to the government which the government can freely use to fund its operating objectives, such as acquiring of capital assets or repaying its debt is controlled by the government.
- ix. Government Business Enterprise means a department or agency that has all the following characteristics:
- Is an entity with the power to contract in its own name;
- Has been assigned the financial and operational authority to carry on a business;
- Sells goods and services, in the normal course of its business, to other MDAs and the general public at a full cost recovery;
- Is not reliant on continuing government funding or subvention to remain a going concern (other than







purchases of outputs at arm's length); and

- Is controlled by a public sector management or the government.
- x. Notes to the GPFS include narrative descriptions or more detailed schedules or analyses of amount shown on the face GPFS, as well as additional information

2. General Purpose Financial Statements (GPFS)

The GDFS comprise of Statement of Cash Receipt and Payment and other statements that disclose additional information about the Cash Receipts, Payments and balances controlled by Borno State Government, and Accounting Policies and note to the Financial Statements. In Borno State, the GPFS account policy include the following:

- i. Statement 1- Statement of Cash Flow: Statement of Cash Receipt and Payment which:
 - recognizes all Cash Receipt, Cash Payments and Cash Balances controlled by the State Government and
 - separately identifies payment made by third parties on behalf of the State Government.
- Statement 2- Statement of Assets and Liabilities: Statement of Financial Position (also known as Balance Sheet);
- iii. Statement 3- Statement of Consolidated Revenue Fund: Statement of Recurrent Financial Performance (also known as Profit & Loss Account);
- iv. Statement 4- Statement of Capital Development Fund: Statement of Capital Financial Performance (also known as Capital Expenditure);
- v. Notes to the Accounts: Additional disclosures to

explain the GPFS; and

vi. Accounting Policies and Explanatory Notes.

3. Basis of Preparation and Legal Provisions

The GPFS are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS) and other applicable standards as defined by the Fiscal Responsibility Law (FRL) and the Financial Reporting Council of Nigeria. In addition, GPFS are in compliance with the provisions of other Financial Regulations of the State.

4. Fundamental Accounting Concepts

The following fundamental accounting concepts are taken as the basis of preparation of all accounts and reporting in Borno State:

- Cash Basis of Accounting;
- Understability;
- Materiality,
- Relevance;
- Going Concern Concept;
- Consistency Concept
- Prudence Completeness, etc,

5. Accounting Period

The accounting year (fiscal year) is from 1st January to 31st December. Each accounting year is divided into 12 calendar months (periods) and are set up as such in the accounting system.







6. Reporting Currency

The General Purpose GPFS are prepared in Nigerian Naira.

7. MDA for Consolidation

The Consolidation of the GPFS are based on the Cash transactions of all Ministries, Department and Agencies (MDAs) of Borno State Government except Government Business Enterprises (GBEs).

8. Comparative Information

The General Purpose GPFS disclose all numerical information relating to previous period/year.

9. Budget Figures

These are figures from the approved annual budget and supplementary budget as approved in accordance with the Appropriation Law of Borno State.

10. Receipts

- These are Cash inflows within the Financial Year. They comprise of receipts from Statutory Allocations (FAAC monthly disbursement), Taxes, External Assistance (from Bilateral and Multilateral Agencies), Other Aid and Grants, Other Borrowings, Capital Receipts (Sale of Government Assets, etc), Receipts from Trading activities and Other Cash Receipts.
- These items are disclosed at the face of the Statement of Cash Receipts and Payments for the year in accordance with the standardised GPFS. Notes are provided as per standardised Notes to GPFS.

11. External Assistance

- Receipts from Loans are Funds received from external sources to be paid back at an agreed period of time. They are categorised either as Bilateral or Multilateral.
- External Loans receipts are disclosed separately under Statement of Cash Receipts and Payment for the year.

12. Other Borrowings / Grants & Aid Received

These are categorised as either Short or Long term Loans. Short-Term Loans are those repayable within one calendar year (12 months), while Long-Term Loans and Debts that fall due beyond one calendar year (above 12 months). Loans are disclosed separately and Grants are also separately disclosed under Statement of Cash Receipts and Payment for the year.

13. Interest Received

Interest actually received during the financial year are treated as a receipt under item 'Other Receipts'

14. Government Business Activities

Cash Receipts from Trading Activities are received net (after deducting direct expenses) unless otherwise provided for by law or policy in force. Total receipts from all trading activities are disclosed in the Statement of Cash Receipts and Payments under 'Trading Activities' item.

Where gross revenue is received, corresponding payments are charged under a corresponding payment item head 'Government Business Activities' in the Statement of Receipts and Payments.





15. Payments

- These are recurrent and Capital Cash Outflows made during the financial year and are categorised either by Function and/or by Sector in the Statement of Cash Receipts and Payment.
- Payments for purchase of items of capital nature e.g.
 PPE) are expended in the year in which the item is purchased. It is disclosed under capital payments. Investments in PPE are also treated in the same way as Capital Purchases. At the end of the financial year, a schedule of assets are provided as part of the Notes to GPFS.

16. Loans Granted:

Payments to other Government and Agencies in form of Loans during the year are shown separately in the Statement of Receipts and Payments. Amount disclosed are actual amount paid during the year.

17. Loan Repayments

Cash receipts from loans granted to other agencies and government are classified under loan repayments in the Statement of Receipts and Payments. Amount disclosed are actual amount received during the year.

18. Interest on Loans:

Actual Interest on loans and other bank commissions charged on Bank Accounts during the year are treated as payments and disclosed under interest payment in the Statement of Cash Receipts and Payments.

19. Foreign Currency Transactions:

Foreign Currency Transactions throughout the year are converted into Nigerian Naira at the ruling (Central Bank of Nigeria –BN) rate of exchange at the dates of the transactions. Foreign currency balances, as at the year end, are translated at the exchange rates prevailing on that date.

The end of the financial year, additional amounts (in cash or at bank) arising out of Foreign Exchange Gains/Losses are recognised in the Statement of Cash Receipts and Payments either as Receipts / Payments respectively.

20. Prepayments:

Prepaid expenses are amounts paid in advance of receipt of goods or services and are charged directly to the respective expenditure item.

21. Investments:

Cash Payments made for investment purposes such as purchase of Government Stock, Treasury Bills and Certificates of Deposit, are Capital Costs and are disclosed as purchase of Financial Instruments or may be given an appropriate name as the case may be. They are separately disclosed in the GPFS (Statement of Receipts and Payments) under capital payments.

22. Leases:

Cash Payment for Finance Leases, which effectively transfer to the Government substantially all the risks and benefits incidental to ownership of the leased item, are treated as capital payments and disclosed in the







Statement of Cash Receipts and Payments

Operating lease cash payments, where the lessors effectively retain substantially all the risks and benefits of ownership of the leased items, are treated as operating expenses.

23. Cash Balance:

This includes Cash in Hand, at Bank and Cash Equivalents at the end of the Financial year.

24. Advances:

All Cash Advances are retired before the end of the financial year. However should circumstances occur (including an Emergency) where either an advance is given out close to the financial year end or an advance already given could not be accounted for, such an advance (or balance outstanding) are treated as cash equivalent since there shall be no proof that such funds have been utilised.





STATEMENT OF THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF AUDITOR GENERAL




FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS FOR THE 2019 FINANCIAL YEAR

The year 2019 Budget size was N144,739,477,375. This comprises of Capital Expenditure Estimate of N80,713,304,000 and Recurrent Expenditure Estimate of N64,026,173,375. The Capital Expenditure estimate represents 55.76% of the Budget size while Recurrent Expenditure Estimate stood at 44.24% of the Budget size of the year under review.




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Fig. 6 Bar Chart Showing Total Expenditure Performance


