



## ROAD WORTHINESS CERTIFICATE

STEPS	ACTIVITIES	TIME FRAME DURATION
1	The Vehicle owner, presents His/Her vehicle for Inspection at the premises of the Borno State Internal Revenue Service along Kano road opposite Ramat Polytechnic to the Director Motor Vehicle Inspector's Office.	Applicant's decision
2	The Vehicle Inspection Officer (VIO) assesses and inspects the car and particulars of the car. If the car passes the inspection and the car particulars are up to date. The assessment is given to the Motor licensing Administration (MLA) department for generation of RRR	Applicant's decision
3	The Payment amount into non-expendable TSA account through Remita amount depends on the vehicle type and use: Private vehicles is ₦1,250 and ₦3,750 for commercial.	2
4	Certificate road worthiness is stamped, signed and issued to the applicant by VIO.	2

### Guide to Remita Payment

This covers all forms of payment made in favor of Borno State Internal Revenue Service.

Follow the steps below to experience a swift payment process to Borno State Internal Revenue Service.

- Type [www.remita.net](http://www.remita.net) on your web browser
- Click on 'Pay TSA & States'
- Click on Borno State Government
- On the field 'Who do you want to Pay' Type Revenue... A drop down with Borno State Internal Revenue Service will pop up. Click on it and supply the following information

- Name of Service
- Amount to pay
- Payer's Name
- Phone number
- Payer's Email
- Click on the check box 'I am not a robot' if asked
- Click on SUBMIT button to proceed

You can now make payment via any of the payment channels convenient for you as follows:

Bank Branch	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Generate your remita retrieval reference (RRR) from <a href="http://www.remita.net">www.remita.net</a></li> <li>■ Visit any bank branch</li> <li>■ Present your payment details to the Teller (over-the-counter) and say you want to pay <b>FEE for BORNO STATE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE</b> via the Remita Platform</li> </ul>
Internet Banking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Log into your bank's Internet banking site</li> <li>■ Click on "Remita"</li> <li><b>To make payment without RRR</b></li> <li>■ Under <b>REMITA PAYMENT</b> select 'Remita without RRR'</li> <li>■ Click on "<b>Select Biller</b>" and enter <b>BORNO STATE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE</b></li> <li>■ Click on "<b>Service Type</b>" to select type of tax you want to pay</li> <li>■ Enter other payment details to complete your payment</li> <li><b>To make payment with RRR</b></li> <li>■ Under "<b>REMITA PAYMENT</b>" select "Remita Payment"</li> </ul>

Remita Collection Platform	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Access the e-Collection platform via <a href="http://www.remita.net">www.remita.net</a> or on our website</li> <li>■ Click on <b>"PAY TSA &amp; STATES"</b></li> <li>■ Click on <b>"WHO DO YOU WANT TO PAY"</b> and enter <b>BORNO STATE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE</b></li> <li>■ Click on <b>"Service Type"</b> to select the type of fee you</li> </ul>
<p>Enter other payment details as required and click <b>"SUBMIT"</b> to generate RRR</p>	



■ Select any preferred electronic payment channel (Cards, Internet banking Mobile Wallet, POS etc.) to complete your payment

■ Generate RRR as explained above

■ Log into MDA's Initiator's Remita Profile

■ Go to **"PAYMENTS"**

■ Select **"MAKE PAYMENTS"** and click on **"PAY RRR BILLS AND INVOICES"**

● Enter RRR in the field provided and click on **"CONTINUE"**

■ Select account to pay from and click **"PROCESS"** to complete payment according to the existing payment workflow

Payers will be issued with an electronic receipt following payment, which the payer can take to the Finance department of BORNO STATE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE for confirmation in order to receive the applicable service.
